Fawdon Children's centre is a Children's and Families hub, run by [Action for Children](#). It includes:

- [North East Autism Hub](#): for parents and carers of children under the age of 7, before, during and after receiving a diagnosis of autism. The hub offers: Introduction to autism workshops, one to one appointments, drop in sessions. Contact kerrie.highcock@ne-as.org.uk to book a session.

The Hub links with smaller organisations and services across their locality, including the voluntary sector organisations and schools to create a network of buildings in each locality.

Services that will be available from hubs include: health visiting, family support, community midwifery, mental health support, children's therapies, youth provision, training opportunities, childcare and employability services.
