The Blue Badge Scheme is a European wide scheme. It allows people who have applied and qualify for a Blue Badge to park in spaces that are reserved for disabled people. The person with the badge can be the driver or the passenger.

The Team at Newcastle City Council process applications for blue badges. You can get more information about the scheme, how to renew your badge and the disabled parking spaces in Newcastle.
