They can:

- give practical advice and emotional support
- help people who have just got a dementia diagnosis to supporting carers after someone has died .
- help you understand dementia and how to cope with its challenges.
- be your main contact, making sure support is linked across health and social care services.
- tell you about other useful services and speak to professionals for you.
- support you to plan ahead and make decisions such as moving into care.
