Building Futures East is a charity who provides intensive employment support, careers advice, basic skills training and wellbeing support across the city but with a key focus upon Walker and Byker. They also offer:

- emergency food parcels, hygiene products and cat and dog food to residents in Byker and Walker only. Referral needed from a professional such as GP, jobcentre work coach, social prescriber or social worker
- coaching, skills development & careers advice to help you prepare for work
- a community garden growing fresh produce that is available to people who use the project
- support community groups and provide 1-1 support through [their Community hub at Tree Top Village](#)

They also have a conference room for up to 12 people available for hire.
